DAY 7

(FOR CFC MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES)

Prayer Points

MARRIAGES

Genesis 2:24

Prayer Points:

1. Lord help couples to love their mate above all else – 1 Peter 4:8
2. Lord, help us to understand two is better than one (Ecclesiastes 4:12).
Help us accept each other no matter their faults.
3. Lord help us to be completely humble and gentle, patient, bearing with one another in love. Making every effort to keep the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace – Ephesians 4:2-3
4. God help me to see my spouse as you see him/her. Forgive us, Lord, for angry words spoken, wrong actions taken, and broken the covenant.
5. Allow our children to see parents who care, love, and communicate because the marriage they will duplicate will be the one they see between us.
6. We invoke your supernatural power in our marriage. Help us and strengthen us to keep you as the focus of our marriage.

DAY 11

MORE OF HIS WEALTH

(FINANCES & PROVISION)

Deuteronomy 28:12; Isaiah 48:17; Psalm 35:27; 84:11; Proverbs 13:22

Prayer Points:

1. Father, I thank you that you are my source of supply. Help me to attack my lack by applying the wisdom of Your Word

2. Lord You said, you would bless the work of our hands, pay our debts and live on the rest. Based on that word, I break every yoke of bondage, the yoke of borrowing, and the yoke of overspending from my life.
3. I decree that this is the year of the Lord's release. I receive it and thank you, Lord. Father, in the Name of Jesus, I thank You that You will bring increase and cause me to profit even right amid difficulties.

DAY 12

MORE OF HIS CONNECTIONS (CAREER)

Mark 8:34; Matthew 28:20; Proverbs 3:5-6; 16:3; 18:9

Prayer Points:

1. Lord Jesus, I chose to be a cross-bearer in the marketplace (Mark 8:34). I want people to see you through me. So on my job, I will carry your cross. In unseen and unspoken ways, people will know there's a difference in my life.
2. According to Psalm 139:3, Lord you are acquainted with all of my ways. Reveal to me my strengths and weaknesses. Give me the wisdom to leverage my strengths for Your Glory and to seek assistance with my weaknesses. Teach me how to make changes, which will take me to a new level of excellence in my career.
3. In Matthew 28:20, "You said you would be with me always." I need your help to demonstrate the technical, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills

required for my work or the position I seek (if preparing for an interview).

DAY 13

MORE OF HIS TRUE SERVANTS

(PASTORS)

1 Timothy 5:17; Isaiah 66:2;

Prayer Points:

1. Father, You have said that the one you esteem is he who is humble and contrite in spirit, and who trembles at Your Word (Isa. 66:2). May our pastor be such a person.
2. Lord, may our pastor fear You so that he will have a secure fortress that will always be a refuge for his children (Prov. 14:26). May he consistently teaches his children to revere your commands by following his example (Psa. 34:11), so that they might be blessed (Psa. 112:1-2). Help him to manage his family well
3. May our love his wife just as Christ loved the Church (Eph. 5:25). Help him to be considerate and respectful to her so that nothing will hinder his prayers (1 Pet. 3:7). Faithful Lord, strengthen and protect our pastor

and his family against the attacks of the enemy (2 Thess. 3:3), and may their household always choose to serve You (Josh. 24:15)

4. Glorious God, we pray that our pastor will seek you with all of his heart. Help him never to stray from your commands. DAY 14

Jeremiah 30:17; Isaiah 53:5; Psalm 30:2-3; 43:5; 103:2-4; 107:19-20; 1Peter 2:24.

Prayer Points:

1. Lord, I just claim the miracle of healing in my life and the lives of my loved ones
2. Speak against every sickness and disease that is killing people at a very fast rate.
3. I pray today that let God arise and let the enemy of my (other peoples) health be scattered in the name of Jesus
4. Whatever God has not planted in my body, I command it to come out because my body is the temple of God therefore sickness and infirmity die in the name of Jesus

5. We declare it loud and clear by the stripes of our Lord Jesus Christ, I am healed in the name of Jesus
6. Lord, visit every part of my body now and perform surgery doctors of the world cannot understand in Jesus' name.
7. LORD continue to extend your hand of mercy towards us, our families, CFC as a whole, and exempt us from this demonic sickness or other sicknesses. [**Ezra 7:28; Exodus 23:25**]
8. LORD by your mercies, end this evil pandemic (i.e. COVID 19) in the United States and around the world in the name of Jesus. [**Psalm 6:4; Psalm 34:4-7**]
9. Let the west wind of the LORD blow this evil plaque away from our world so that life can return to normalcy. [**Exodus 10:19**]
10. LORD, let the number of cases for each day reduce drastically and let all those who have contracted this disease to be healed in Jesus' name. [**Jeremiah 17:14; Jeremiah 33:6**]
11. We block and curse new cases to die in the name of Jesus, and we prevent it from spreading in the nation and the world.

DAY 15

MORE OF HIS ECONOMY IN USA

1. Pray for the state of the U.S. economy. The number of newly laid-off workers filing claims for unemployment benefits last week increased.

Pray for those in dire needs that Lord will provide relief and for those of us with wealth and abundance to increase our charity and support.

2. Pray that our government leaders are given Godly wisdom and knowledge to create jobs for the unemployed, and to lift the state of poverty among the people who are homeless and hungry.
3. Pray for the financial situations many are in because of this economic mess. Ask the Lord to deliver us, and break the chains of financial bondage we face at this time.
4. Pray that the Lord will help us to overcome all our frustrations with the negative news we hear on TV and the media.
5. Pray that God will guide and support this Nation to move towards stability and prosperity, and for the government to make wise and Godly decisions with the country's national resources. (Psalm 127:1)
6. We pray for those who have lost money in investments that they will have the peace of God and new direction. Restore our trust in You, Lord, and our faith that you will work things out for the good. (Romans 2:28)
7. Pray also for the President that he will please the Lord and do what God wants.

DAY 16

MORE OF HIS REWARDS IN MY LIFE

(Release, restoration, and rewards)

Joel 2:12, 25-26

Prayer Points:

1. Lord as we humble ourselves before you in fasting and prayer, thank You for releasing us from our past & forgiving all our sins.
2. Thank you, Lord, for restoring to us all that the enemy stole from us. We receive the benefits of eternal life as we continue to fast.
3. Lose the bands of wickedness. Undo the heavy burdens. Let the oppressed go free. 'Release' us to walk in financial freedom. 'Release' us from fear of the future. 'Release' us from depression, abuse, nicotine, and addictions of all kinds – Isaiah 58:6
4. We receive double for our trouble – Zachariah 8:12; 9:12

DAY 17

MORE OF HIS FIRE IN MY LIFE

(REVIVAL)

2 Chronicles 7:14

Prayer Points:

1. Lord we pray for spiritual brokenness, deep conviction of sin, and genuine repentance among God's people. Lord let it start with me – Acts 3:19
2. Father, we pray that you bestow spiritual-hunger in the hearts of your people and draw us to fervent intercession.

3. Lord, give unto your church a fervent desire for love and unity and let there be a deep harmony among believers. We pray for healing for those who are hurt and help us to stop unnecessary competition among us.
(John 13:35)
4. Lord, we pray that you pour out your Spirit like a mighty purifying flood. Purify our motives as we pray for revival. We desire nothing but your glory and kingdom increase.
5. Lord, we pray for conviction and salvation upon communities of influence (actors, government officials, educators, teachers, news and media people, talk show hosts, comedians, LGBT, and the music industry).

DAY 18

MORE OF HIS VICTORY IN MY LIFE

1 John 5:4

Prayer Points:

1. Father, we declare that we are overcomers. Our faith makes us overcomers, not our feelings. You are with us now as You have been and forever shall be. We praise You for total victory. We are driving the devil out.
2. In the name of Jesus, We command every stronghold of Satan in our lives and our family to be pulled down – 2 Corinthians 10:5

3. We decree and declare that every foundation of Satan in our lives be uprooted in Jesus name
4. Every assignment of evil forces against our lives be terminated in Jesus name - Zechariah 3:1
5. Father, we unlock all prison doors that are holding those who have been sent to help us. We demand their release in Jesus name – Daniel 10:12-13
6. We demand the return of lost inheritance, health, wealth, fame, and spiritual dominion. Deuteronomy 28:1-14

DAY 19

MORE OF PRAYER IN MY LIFE

John 15:4-5; 1 Samuel 12:23

Prayer Points:

1. Lord, you said if Your Word abides in us, we could ask what we will and it shall be done. So Lord let our will conform to your will. Do what you want in our lives. (Luke 22:42)
2. We are asking You, Father, to put on us a new mantle for prayer. Teach us how to abide in Your presence daily.
3. Lord make us intercessors who are willing to be emptied, broken, made anew, and filled with living breath. Let us become intercessors fashioned in Your love.

4. We ask you heavenly father that we will be persistent in our prayers until each task is done.
5. Lord let our prayers be a constant flow as we represent others to you and plead their cause. Let us not give up praying for others.

DAY 20

MORE OF HIS COMPASSION IN MY LIFE

1 John 3:17-18

Prayer Points:

1. Touch our hearts. We feel the influence of worldliness and materialism and the cares of this life. Touch us. We don't want to be hard-shelled. We want to be tender. We want to be sensitive like the Good Samaritan. We want to show the world your compassion and grace – Luke 10:30-33
2. Allow us to be as compassionate as the air we breathe. Give us the strength to help people who have fallen by the wayside.
3. Cause us to be a blessing to others as we travel through life's journey. Help us to leave a positive impact on the people that surround us.
4. Like the Good Samaritan, help us to reschedule our activities to be a part of other people's lives, bind up their wounds lord Jesus – Luke 10:34-35
5. Lord, help us to address brokenness and sin without rebuke when necessary.

DAY 21

MORE OF HIS WORSHIP IN MY LIFE

John 4:23

Prayer Points:

1. Lord, we surrender our lives to you because we desire a higher and deeper level of intimacy with you. Give us a fresh revelation of who you are during our times of worship (Joel 2:12-13)
2. We pray for heightened sensitivity to the flow and move of the Holy Spirit both in our individual lives and incorporate worship as a church.
3. We pray for greater outpourings of God's presence in our worship experiences when we meet as a church.
4. We pray for our worship team that they will grow consistently closer to Jesus, lead worship out of the overflow of their walk with God, and live life on integrity.
